(NOTE: "Field only" athletes must complete either 3D or Target criteria to qualify)

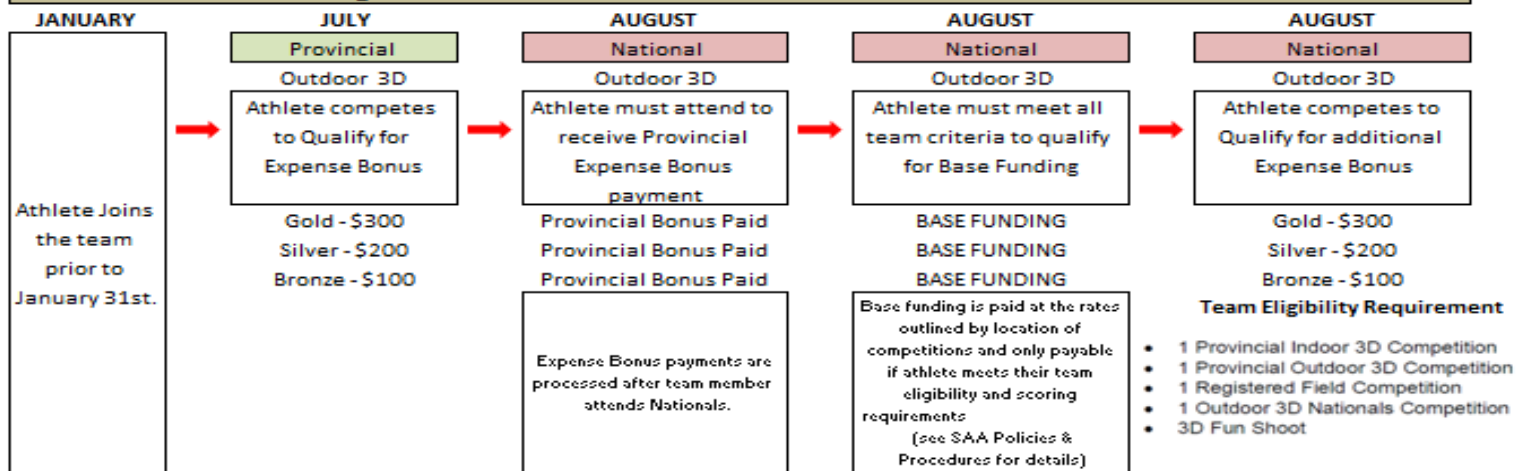

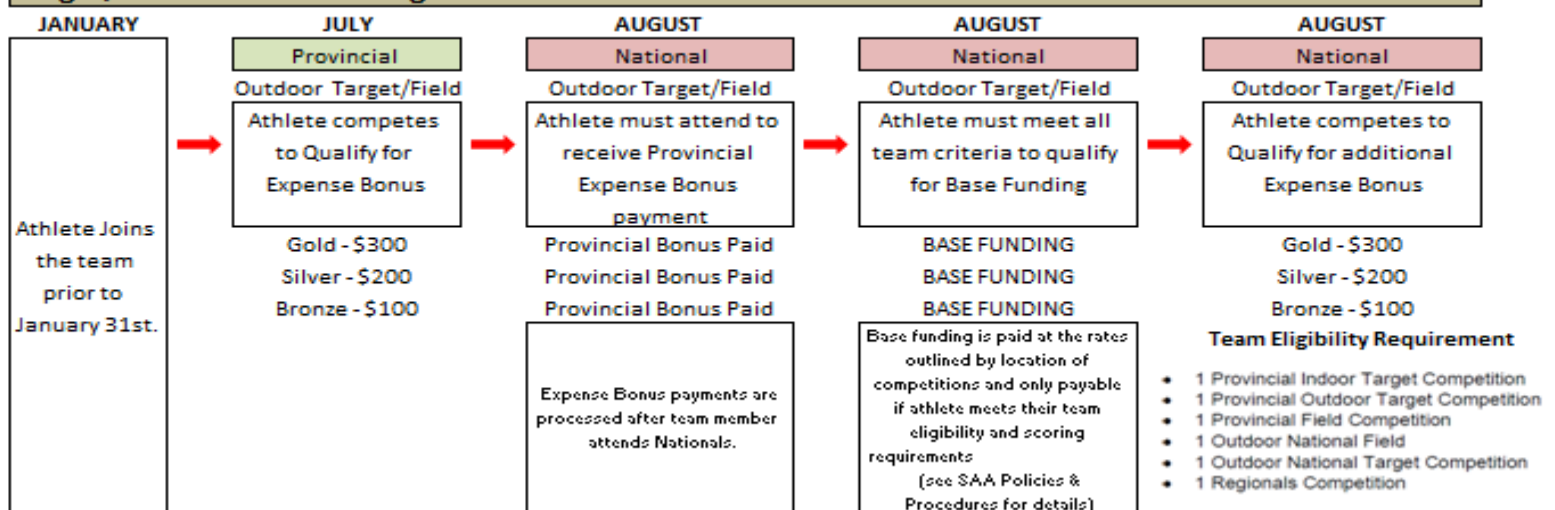

3D/ Field - Tier 1 Funding

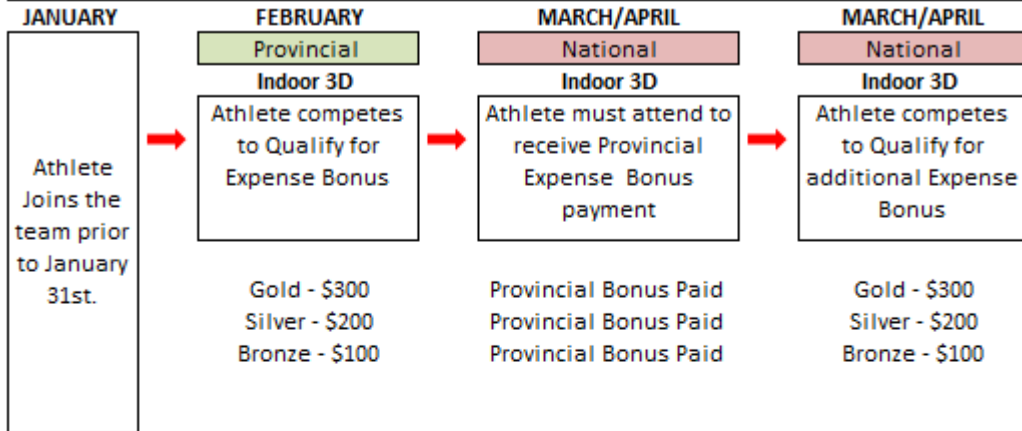


Target/ Field - Tier 1 Funding

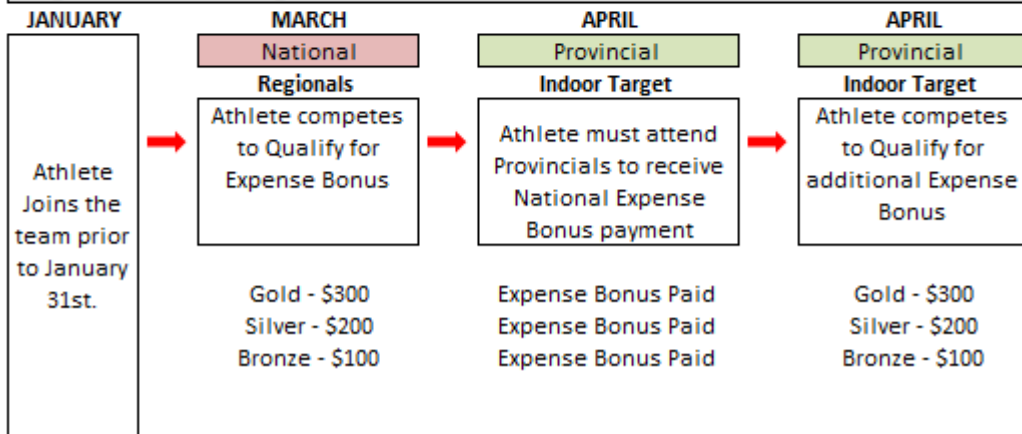


Indoor National Level Funding

3D - Tier 2 Funding

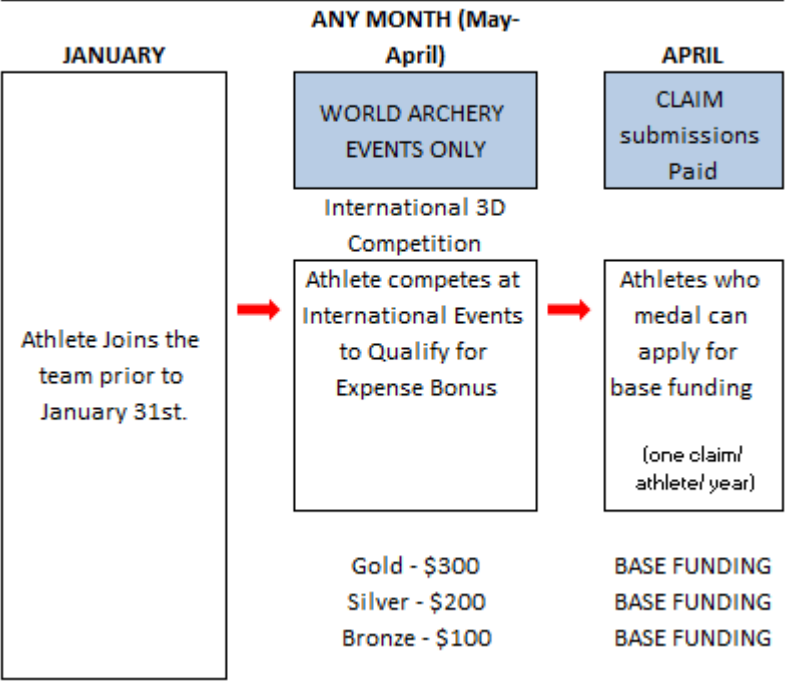


Target - Tier 2 Funding

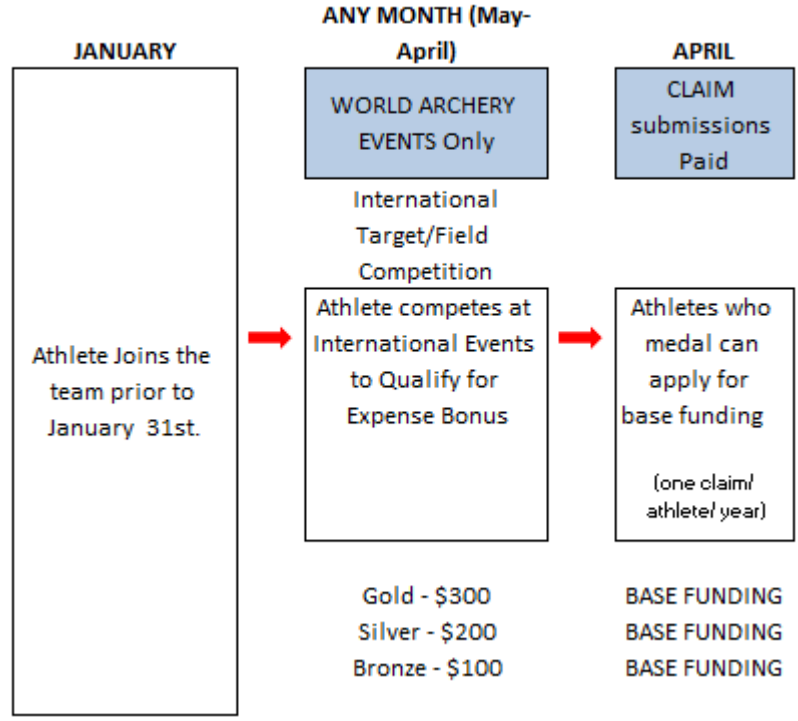


International Level Funding

Frequently Asked Questions

Do I need to join more than one team if I want to get funding for more than one event? NO, joining the Sask Archery team is a requirement for funding regardless of the archery discipline(s) (3D / Target/ Field) you choose to participate in. There will no longer be segregated teams.

Will I be able to apply for base funding for each events separately? NO, You will only receive one base funding amount to attend a national event regardless of the number of events you choose to participate in. You will be able to apply for expense bonuses based on the disciplines you chose to join when you signed up for the team and the funding criteria, outlined in policy, you have completed.

What shoots do I need to attend in order to qualify for funding? The target and 3D team criteria in the policies has not changed. To qualify for target funding you must complete the Target shoot criteria, to qualify for 3D funding you must complete the 3D shoot criteria. If you choose to shoot the field event only, you must complete either the target or 3D shoot criteria to qualify for funding. Athletes must complete the funding criteria in policies to claim for funding in each discipline.

Do I still need to submit receipts? YES, Sask Archery cannot pay athlete funding without supporting documentation that expenses were incurred. Receipts must be presented and support the amounts equal to or higher than the amount of funding the athlete is eligible to receive or funding can only be paid at up to the eligible receipts total.

What receipts are eligible for submission to support my funding application? The SAA will accept receipts from economy flights (return), fuel receipts (when driven), extra baggage fees, competition registration, car rental and accommodations. Receipt dates must align with the event dates.

NOTE: *Any receipts claimed on a primary submission and/or paid by another entity cannot be claimed to the SAA for a second benefit as there would have been no expenses to the athlete. However if there were amounts not paid by the primary funder and you have the receipts then these expenses do qualify for submission to the SAA as a secondary expense claim. Simply put if there are no expenses to the athlete there should not be an expenses claim (receipt) submission. Failure to report funding from other source constitutes fraud.*

When do I qualify for expense bonuses funding? If you join the team in January and you attend the required shoots in that calendar year, you are eligible to apply for funding in the same calendar year.

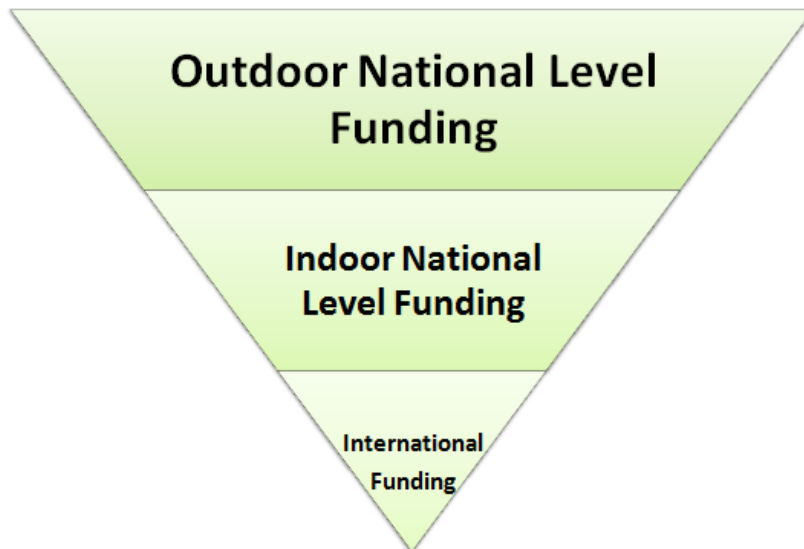
