Re: Suspending/ Postponing the JOP Championship and Indoor Target Provincial Championships

The COVID-19 virus situation has caused many groups, including Sask Archery Association, to reassess upcoming public events and gatherings. With the announcement this afternoon from the Chief Medical Officer of Saskatchewan banning public gatherings of over 250 people in an effort to limit the spread of COVID-19, we will be suspending the JOP and Indoor Target Championships scheduled for April 18 & 19, 2020 at this time.

Over the coming weeks, the SAA Board of Directors will be watching the alerts around the virus and will be in discussions to determine if it is viable to reschedule these events at a later date. The SAA website, Facebook and your JOP Coordinators will keep you apprised of any decisions brought forth from the board.

If you have booked hotel rooms we recommend cancelling those. Further correspondence will follow from Timberland Bowbenders regarding refunds for prepaid registrations.

In light of this outbreak and the potential risks, we would ask that each club assess its planned club activities and make decisions in the best interest of your club and athletes across the province.
